Other media or formats will not be accepted for submission. Additionally, in the case of artworks besides video and musical composition – artworks created on independently developed software or websites that require an internet connection, and for works that cannot be submitted in their original form, it is possible to submit them on a USB stick (abiding to the above conditions) containing a compilation introducing the works as a video recording. Upon submission, please attach an “Additional Screening Materials Label” to those medias and fill out your full name on it.

- Furthermore, in the event that the total time for all the visual or audio materials exceeds 10 minutes, applicants are to compile all materials into one (within 10 minutes), create an edited “digest” (summary) version and submit.

9 Entrance Exam

Entrance Exam Date (Oral Exam) June 20, 2026

Exam Method Online examination (preliminary connection test must be done by the Entrance Exam Date)
*Methods of examination and preliminary connection test will be announced by the IAMAS Academic Office after the application is made.

Oral Exam – Schedule and Format Oral Examination (online)
*The interview start time will be announced by the IAMAS Academic Office after the application is made.

The allotted time for each oral exam is 30 minutes. The first 10 minutes are for the individual presentation and the final 20 minutes are for questions. On your application, select whether you will use Japanese or English for your interview examination.

If you select Japanese, you will be asked additional questions in English (to which you must respond in English) to verify your English ability. If you select English, you will be asked additional questions in Japanese (to which you must respond in Japanese) to verify your Japanese ability.

If you selected Screening I, give a presentation about your activities in your affiliated organization.

If you select Screening II, give a presentation about your activities and works you created.

11 Announcement of Results

Announcement date: July 3, 2026

Results of the Commendation Entrance Exam will be sent to you and your university or technical college. IAMAS will not give results over the phone; however, if 5 days have passed since the designated date and you still have not been contacted, you may call the Educational Affairs Office to inquire.

Examinees living overseas will be contacted via e-mail, phone, or other means. Please contact the Academic Office if you need documents mailed to you. You do not need to provide the return envelopes (7-5, 7-6) mentioned on page E5.

12 Admission Procedures

Payment of Admission Fees & Submission of Payment Receipt (copy)

Admission Fees:	Resident of Gifu Prefecture – 226,000 yen
	Non-resident of Gifu Prefecture – 338,000 yen

A “resident” is defined as any individual whose home address has been located within Gifu Prefecture since at least one year prior to entering the school, or any individual who has a first-degree relative (i.e., a parent) or spouse that fulfills this requirement. A “non-resident” is any individual who does not fulfill “resident” status requirements.

When you pass the Entrance Exam, we will give you your acceptance letter and contact you with information about how to pay your admission fees. To enroll in the school, you must pay your admission fees by the deadline. IAMAS reserves the right to change admission fees without notice.

In order to confirm your intention to enroll, you must submit a payment receipt (copy).

13 Moving into the Student Dormitory (RIST)

Starting from the 2024 academic year, the student dormitory (RIST) will gradually be shifted to the Sophia Flats, a prefectural housing complex adjacent to the university. The requests for tenancy will be surveyed in mid-February and the decision of the students who will live in RIST or the Sophia Flats will be determined via lottery. In either case, entry into the dormitories will be possible from April 1st onwards.

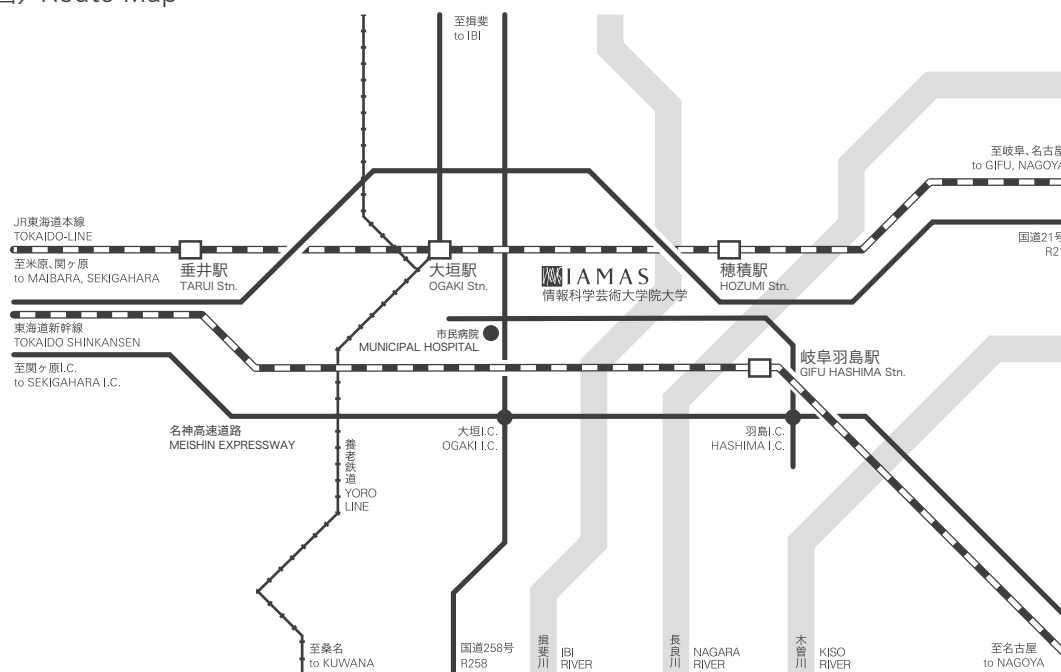
The personal information IAMAS collects for the entrance exam will only be used for the following purposes:

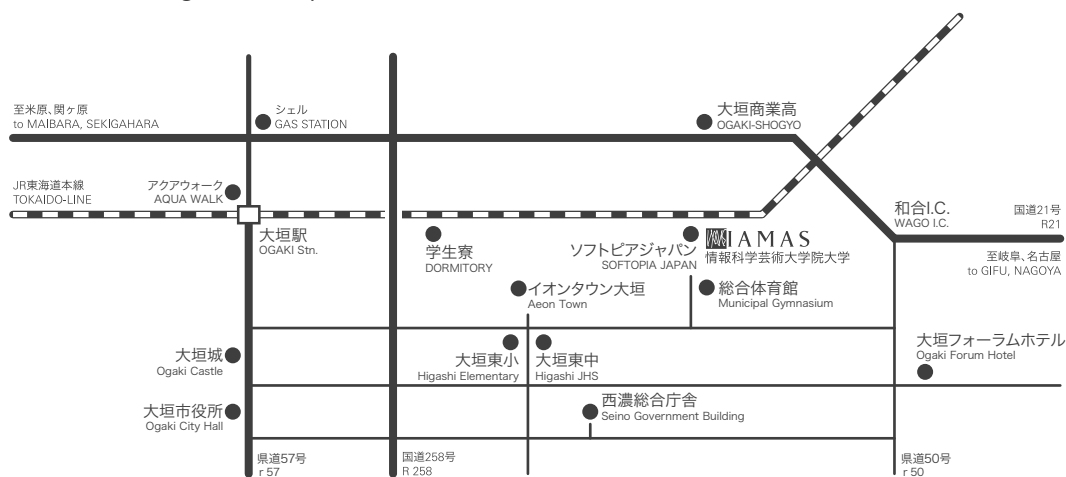
